Circular:

The state Government has announced the Electronics & IT/ITeS Start-up Policy for the State of Gujarat (2016-21) vide G.R. read at (1) & (2) above. This Policy has following incentives for eligible startups as per the provision under para 2.9 of the policy.

In e-Governance projects undertaken by Government Departments or its Boards, Corporations or parastatal bodies getting budgetary support, a provision will be made for outsourcing of 5 % to 10 % of the contract value either as outsourcing of service or as job work to the eligible start-ups and to students of shortlisted Technical Colleges in Gujarat under this policy. The responsibility for adhering to the Service Level Agreement (SLA) has been vested in the solution provider or the system integrator.


For enablement of above provision, following instructions are circulated to all Government Departments:

- Now onwards, all Government Departments and their consultants, while preparing Request for Proposal (RFP) /Tenders for implementing any IT /e-governance Project should make suitable

provisions incorporating 5 to 10% Outsourcing / Job work of the contract value to be given to Startups & Students of Technical Colleges in Gujarat.

- This provision will apply for acquisition of Hardware / Software suites / development of applications. Kind of outsourcing that will be done, will be decided by the solution provider or the system integrator. However, as an indicative list, hardware supply and configuration, module development, mobile application development etc. are components which can be outsourced.
- Consultants like GIL/GIPL/NIC/iNDEXT-b, who are assisting/facilitating Government Departments in their IT/ e-Governance projects shall take due care while preparing the Request for Proposal (RFP)/Tender for implementing any IT /e-governance Project incorporating above provisions.
