No.GST/04/2016/DIT/10/2015/DyDir/IT:- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Deputy Director of IT, Class-I, in the General State Services, under the Directorate of Information and Communication Technology and e-Governance, Gujarat State namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Deputy Director of IT, Class-I, in the General State Services, under the Directorate of Information and Communication Technology and e-Governance Recruitment Rules, 2016
2. Appointment to the post of Deputy Director of IT, Class-I, in the General State Services, under the Directorate of Information and Communication Technology and e-Governance, Gujarat State, shall be made either, -
 - (a) by promotion of a person who possess "very good" benchmark for being considered fit for promotion within the zone of consideration as laid down in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 from amongst the persons who, -
 - (i) have worked for not less than five years in the cadre of Assistant Director of IT, Class-I, in the General State Services, under the Directorate of Information and Communication Technology and e-Governance ;

- (ii) have passed the departmental examination prescribed by the Government; and
- (iii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006:

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience specified in sub-clause (i) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period; it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two-thirds of the period specified in sub-clause (i) above; or

Provided further that the Government may appoint a person who possess the educational qualification and experience as specified in rule 4 against the promotion quota on contract basis for not exceeding one year in consultation with the Gujarat Public Service Commission; or

- (b) by direct selection ; or
- (c) by temporary transfer on deputation basis from amongst the persons working in the Central Government or State Government or Government Undertaking Board or Corporation and who possess the educational qualification and experience as specified in rule 4 till the candidates not available for the post.

3. The appointments by direct selection and promotion shall be made in the ratio of 1:2 respectively.

4. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall, –

(a) not be more than 45 years of age;

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.

Provided further that nothing contained in clause (b) of sub-rule (9) of rule 8 of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (general) Rules, 1967 shall be applicable in so far relaxation of upper age limit as prescribed above is concerned:

(b) possess –

(i) a degree of Bachelor of Engineering or Bachelor of Technology in Information Technology or Computer Science or Computer Engineering or Electronics or Electronics and Communication or Computer Technology or a degree of Master of Computer Application or Master of Science (IT) obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956, and

(ii) have about ten years cumulative experience in the field of Computer Technology or Communication Technology or Information Technology in any organization of Government or Local Bodies or in a Company whose

annual turnover of Rs. 50 crores or above and which is established under the Companies Act, 2013;


(c) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules 1967; and

(d) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.

5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.
6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, require to undergo pre-service training and pass the post-training examination in accordance with the provisions of the Gazetted Officer's Pre-Service Training and Examination Rules, 1970.
7. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, require to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
8. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to pass the examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
9. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to pass the examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
10. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to undergo such training and to pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.

11. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by Government.
